## Code of Safety Practice

1  
All persons shall follow these Safe practices rule, render every possible aid to operations, And report all unsafe condition or practices to the foreman or superintendent.

2  
Foreman shall insist on employees observing and obeying every rule, Regulation, and order as is necessary to the safe conduct of the work, and shall take such action as is necessary to obtain abseance.

3  
All employees shall be (are given) frequent accident prevention. Instructions Shall be given at least every 10 working days. Weekly tailgate Safety meeting at the job site shall be attended by those employees at that job site & or prior to each starting as a new worker.

4  
Anyone known to be under the influence of drugs or intoxicating substance which impairs the employee's ability to safely perform the assigned duties Shall not be allowed on the job site in that condition

5  
All electric toll shall be grounded properly.

6  
Hard hats shall be worn whenever these are overhead obstruction.

7  
The supervising foreman at the job site shall have first aid certificate and be certified in CPR.

8  
No horseplaying or fooling at job site is allowed.

9  
Work shall be well planned and supervised to prevent injuries to worker and the public.

10  
Employees shall not enter manholes, underground vaults, chambers or other similar places that received title ventilation. Unless it is determined that it is safe to enter.

Employees shall be instructed to insure that all guards and other protective devices are in proper places and adjusted and shall report differences promptly to the foreman or superintendent.
- 12  
Worker shall not handle or tamper with electrical equipment, machinery or air or water lines in a manner not within the scope of their duties, unless they have received instructions from their foreman.
- 13  
All injuries shall reported promptly to the foreman or superintendent so that a arrangement can be made for medical or first aid treatment.
- 14  
When lifting heavy objects, the large muscles of the leg instead of smaller muscles of the back shall be used.
- 15  
All shirts must be tacked in at the waist. No loose clothing is permissible on the job site.
- 16  
Safety glasses must be worn while using electrical tools.
- 17  
Ear/sound protectors shall be worn around loud equipment noises.
- 18  
Hand gloves shall be worn while handle rough material; steel, lumber, plywood for example.
- 19  
Inappropriate foot wear or shoes w/their badly worn soles shall not be worn.
- 20  
Material, tools or other objects shall not be thrown from building or structures until proper precaution are taken to protect others from falling objects.
